# Scrap quilt squares

These squares were made by a small group of young people.

Their inspiration came from a mix of ideas from the Museum's sunny garden, symbols on the US flag, and the repeating shapes from the quilts in our collection.



**We used scrap squares of material as a base. Biscuit cutter stencils and cardboard to draw around. Felt tip pens to add additional colour. Scissors and PVA glue to 'hold' it together.**

Everyone got it bit braver as we went on. Some people preferred to work with pencils on a piece of paper, others went straight to using the materials ... and the main point was to experiment!

Making a bit of a mess is part of the process.
